
We welcome abstract submissions for a 20-minute presentation or an A0 poster from all postgraduate, independent, and early career researchers studying ancient Egypt and Sudan, including the Prehistoric/Predynastic, Pharaonic, Late, Graeco-Roman and Islamic periods. Themes may include, but are not limited to: art history, ceramics, current fieldwork, geoarchaeology, material culture, osteoarchaeology, philology, religion, and economy.

Abstracts should consist of no more than 1000 characters and should be submitted by **30th November 2015** to <u>crexviikrakow@gmail.com</u>. Remember to provide us with all names of the authors, their titles (if applicable) and affiliation (if not currently affiliated please note self as an independent researcher).

All conference events will take place in the historical part of the Jagiellonian University in Krakow, Poland.

The official language of the conference is English.
