- Short presentation: 10-minute presentation, plus discussion. These talks are recommended for work-in-progress topics or exploratory papers.
- Poster: The poster is displayed in the foyer of the event location with a dedicated poster session.

Abstract Guidelines:

- The abstract should be no more than 300 words.
- The abstract title should be at most 30 words.
- All abstracts should be in English. Any other language will not be considered.
- It should be uploaded in PDF format.
- Five keywords should be added to the abstracts.
- Please write your name, affiliation, and email address in the header.

- January 19, 2025: Abstract submission deadline.
- March 15, 2025: Acceptance notification

- **2500 EG** for Egyptian and Sudanese speakers.
