The CRE is intended to provide students and early-career researchers with a platform to present their completed and ongoing research to an audience of peers. To this end, we welcome abstracts on all ages and aspects of Egyptology and Nubiology, including, but not limited to:

- Mythology and Religion

- Diversity in Ancient Egypt
- History of Egyptology
- Restoration and Conservation

This year's CRE will provide the following presentation formats:

1. Standard presentation – 20-minute presentation, plus discussion.
2. Short presentation – 10-minute presentation, plus discussion.
3. Poster presentation – Poster displayed in the foyer of the event location, with a dedicated poster session.

Abstracts should be submitted through our [Google Form](#). Abstracts should not exceed **300** words and should be submitted no later than **16 January 2026**. The official language of the conference is **English**. Abstracts will be reviewed anonymously by an external scientific committee. Accepted contributions (oral and poster) will be grouped in sessions and allocated timeslots. The presenting author will be invited to register for the conference and to attend the event in person.

Important dates:

- ◆ 16 January 2026: Deadline for abstract submissions.
- ◆ Late February 2026: Notification of acceptance.
- ◆ Late February–30 April 2026: Early-bird registration.
- ◆ 1 May–30 June 2026: Late registration.
